The wellbeing of our whole school community is of the greatest importance to us. Therefore, we have teamed up with Chichester Wellbeing to offer access to private and confidential, one to one advice and support on Friday 26th January 2024.

The 30-minute appointments give you the opportunity to discuss any aspect of your lifestyle, including emotional well-being, stress management, weight management; healthy eating; exercise; smoking cessation; alcohol awareness; and pre-diabetes. In addition, you can choose to use their body composition scales which not only give weight but BMI, hydration levels, fat percentage etc.
