Dear Parents,

I hope your children all enjoyed their half term holiday and have had a great first week of their final half term of the school year. Over the next few weeks, the whole school is sharing a whole school learning experience about life in the Woods / Forest. Already the children have been busy learning songs and rehearsing for our summer term extravaganza 'Robin Hood'. We are all very much looking forward to this very special event that will involve all the children from across the school and lead straight into our annual summer social on the school field. School Inspections - Section 48

Many of you will know that our school was inspected at the end of last half term. This was a Section 48 inspection which is a Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS). Every church school, whether voluntary controlled or aided, is required to undergo this inspection every 5 – 6 years. Thank you to all the parents who met with the inspector and spoke so highly of our school. I am very pleased to say that the inspector was very impressed by all we do, and the inspection had a very positive outcome. The full report will be sent home early next week.

Attendance

Congratulations to Woodpecker Class who have the highest attendance of last half term. In addition, a very well done to all the children as our overall attendance so far this year is 97% compared to 96% last year. Thank you to all parents who avoid booking holidays during term time. Please can I remind you that I am unable to authorise any holidays during term time and the Local Authority is still issuing fixed term penalty notices. Please therefore ensure that your child is in school every day for the remainder of this term.

Drop off and pickups.

A small number of children are frequently arriving at school unsupervised as early as 8:20am. Unless attending a club, children are not permitted on the school site until 8:40am. The school grounds are not supervised in the morning, as all staff are busy preparing for the day ahead, and children must not be left for long periods of time without adult supervision. If not informed that a child is left unattended, we are not able to ensure their safety. A member of staff is on duty from 8:50 at the turning circle to welcome children into school, and I am outside to greet children as often as possible.

Similarly, at the end of the day there are frequently a number of children who can be waiting for up to fifteen minutes to be picked up which is clearly unacceptable. We are of course happy, in exceptional circumstances, to supervise children but this must be agreed in advanced so that I can ensure the safety of all the children in our care.

I am very pleased to announce however that, due to a good level of interest, we will be running a Breakfast club from September which will helpfully help parents who need to get to work early. More details about this provision will follow shortly.
