Young Voices 2023 – Updates and Key Information

Dear Parents,

Please find below further information about our upcoming trip to the Young Voices 2023 concert at Wembley OVO Arena.

Monday 6th February

What to bring

Children should wear comfortable trousers and trainers, their YV T-shirt (which will be handed out to all those who ordered one in due course) or a plain white t-shirt, and their school jumper. They should bring a warm jacket in case it is cold inside the arena.

Children will need to bring two packed lunches, some healthy snacks and enough drinks for the day.

Children are encouraged to bring a small game (not electronic), paper and a pencil and / or a book to play with on the coach, or during any free time in the day, as long as the items fit comfortably in their bag.

Mobile phones are not permitted on the trip.

1 pm – Venue doors open to schools

2 – 5pm – Rehearsals

6:30 pm – All to be seated by this time

7 – 8:45pm – Concert

9:15 – 9:30pm – Return to coach

11pm - 12am – Return to Lavant for pick up from school (we will endeavour to confirm a more accurate ETA via text or email once we are on the way back from the venue)



Photo Permission

Young Voices do have their own promotional photographer in the venue, but with such a high number of children attending, the chance of our children's photos or video being taken and used in any promotional activities is very slim. In the unlikely event we are asked to participate in a photo opportunity, please do let us know if you'd prefer that your child is not included in the photo and we will do all we can to ensure this is the case.

Travel Sickness Medication

If your child is prone to travel sickness, and would usually take tablets to alleviate any symptoms, please could you administer a tablet in the morning and provide another in a named envelope to Mrs Goman or I so that we can give it to your child before the return trip.

Tuesday 7th February

We understand that the evening of the Young Voices concert will be a later night for all Pheasant children than we would normally expect and that they will likely be very tired the next day. For this reason, we will be offering children the option of arriving at school at 8:45am as normal or arriving later in the morning at 10.30 am. If your child has a sibling in another year group and you would like to bring them in at 10.30am also, please could you advise their class teacher in advance so they can plan accordingly. Should circumstances change in any way, and arrival at normal time is required, we will advise before the morning of the 7th.
