Dear Parents,

**Welcome** to the start of another school year, and an especially warm welcome to all our new children and families across the school. We hope everyone had a great summer and is feeling ready to make the most out of the new school year ahead. The teachers have, as always, worked really hard over the summer to make sure that the children have many exciting and memorable learning experiences over the weeks and months ahead.

## Welcome Meetings and 'Drop in' sessions

We hope that all parents will be able to attend our welcome meetings. At the meeting the class teacher/s will be presenting their expectations for the coming year and there will be opportunities for generic questions. A film will be put on in Goldfinch room for children to watch for the duration of the meeting. Individual parent consultations will be held later in the term. It is really important that parents attend these meetings to ensure you are well informed about the term ahead. Each Welcome meeting will take place in your child's classroom and will be held straight after school.

### **Healthy School – Wake up Wednesday**



This year we are stepping up our commitment to growing healthy minds and healthy bodies. All children will continue to participate in 15 minutes of sustained exercise daily through our 15 minutes of fitness activities; daily mile, skipping, wake up shape up fitness routines and so on.

In addition this year, the whole school will have a strong focus on sport every Wednesday as each class will be taught by James Belding, our specialist sports coach from 'South Coast Sports'. James will also be running fitness clubs at lunchtimes that will have a different focus each term.

We are also re-launching West Sussex County Council's 'Walk once a Week' scheme (WOW) in which the children are encouraged to walk / bike / scoot to school every Wednesday. Each Wednesday the children log how they have travelled to school and will be able to earn badges for taking healthy options of travel. We do hope you will support us in these initiatives and encourage your child in improving their fitness levels.

















## **Swimming**

The parents of children in Key Stage two are reminded that swimming money is now due for the term -  $\pounds 42.00$ . All details regarding swimming were sent home last term, but if you need another copy of this letter, please speak to Mrs. Creswick. The first swimming session is on Thursday  $12^{th}$  September.

Please remember all children must have their PE kits in school every day to enable them to participate in physical activities. PE Kits go home every Friday to be washed but must be returned to school on a Monday morning.

# **Yearly Reminders**

### **School Uniform**

It is fantastic to see all the children looking smart in their school uniform at the start of a new school year. To help you check that your child has the correct uniform I have included a brief reminder below.

#### **Girls**

- Grey pinafore dress/skirt
- Black / charcoal grey trousers (not tracksuit bottoms)
- Red check dresses / two piece culottes in summer
- White polo shirt
- Burgundy sweatshirt or cardigan (purchased from the school office)
- Grey or white socks, Grey or black tights (not patterned)
- Black/navy flat shoes

### **Boys**

- Long or short charcoal grey trousers
- White polo shirt
- Burgundy sweatshirt (purchased from the school office)
- Grey socks, Black shoes (not patterned)

### P.E. kit (boys and girls)

- Burgundy P.E. shorts
- White P.E. T-shirt
- Plimsolls/Trainers
- Maroon P.E. Bag

#### Swimming (KS2 only)

- One-piece Swimming costume/ Swimming Trunks
- Towel

Please note that footwear for boys and girls must be flat shoes (not boots and not trainers). Please ensure that all school uniform and PE kit is clearly named

Please also ensure that your child's hair cut / colour of hair is suitable for school and that all long hair is tied back at all times.

As and when you need to update uniform during the year, please speak to Mrs. Creswick in the school office. For further guidance on school uniform please refer to our school website.

#### **Earrings**

West Sussex guidelines state that pupils should only wear studs, not hoop earrings. If your child does wear earrings, please make sure they can take them out / put them in themselves for PE. If your child is unable to do this (or the earrings cannot yet come out) then please provide them with micro-pore tape to stick over the ears.





### Coats



Although we are all hoping for an "Indian Summer" the weather can always be unpredictable. Please make sure your child has a coat every day even if it seems fine on the way to school. We try to get outside to play even if it isn't totally dry and so your child needs the assurance of a warm rainproof coat every day.

#### **New water bottle**

Every child in school has been given a new water bottle, kindly donated by the Friends of Lavant School. As usual, water bottles will be kept in school each week and all children will be able to fill them with fresh water as required. For hygiene reasons please ensure the bottles are taken home every Friday to be thoroughly washed before being returned to school on a Monday morning. Should you need to replace your child's bottle during the year they can be purchased from the school office for  $\pounds 1.50$ 



## Allergy information

Can we please remind you that nuts or food items containing nuts are **NOT** allowed in school. This includes peanut butter, chocolate spread and certain cereal bars. We appreciate your support in being extra careful when packing your child's lunchbox because we have children in the school who have a severe nut allergy.

### **Birthday Celebrations**

Last year we started a new tradition at Lavant C.E. Primary School; every child may wear non-school uniform to school on their birthday. If their birthday falls at the weekend, or during a holiday they can wear non-school uniform on the Friday before. **Birthdays** are very exciting occasions, especially when you are growing up, and we want all children to feel special for the whole day. We ask however that you do not send in cakes, sweets, or other treats as teachers are not able to hand them out.

#### **Assemblies**

Parents are warmly invited to join us for our weekly Church assembly, led by Rev David Jarrett. These are held every Thursday morning at 9:10am from 12<sup>th</sup> September. We will be celebrating **Harvest on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October**. Our service will be held in school and we will be asking for donations of food produce, preferably tins / packets. Our Year six children will be helping to distribute some of the Harvest produce around the Village on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October.

We look forward to seeing you over the coming weeks. Please do remember that we have an open door policy. If you have a query about anything just ask. If it is class related please **ask your child's teacher,** otherwise **ask at the office or speak to me.**
