

## Wren Class Homework Book March 2020

Dear parents/carers,

As you are aware, most classes will be setting work on a daily basis using our school website. On the Wren Class page you will find a copy of this letter reminding you to use your tapestry log in to enable us to continue to communicate and share learning opportunities.

During the school closure, I will upload work on a daily basis Monday to Friday by 9am using Tapestry. Please see letter attached giving details of how this will work. (This letter has also been sent via parent mail.)

Many resource websites are offering free access for children – see below. We have stuck login and password details for Numbots, Busy Things and others on the yellow exercise book that we are sending home. Do make good use of them. 😊

Please can the yellow book be kept only for responding to activities I set on Tapestry from this Monday.

Here are a few activities for you to do with your child at a time that suits you. Some will complement activities I set on line on Tapestry, others are just basic literacy and language based activities to keep refreshing and updating basic skills.

Please read the 2 sided colourful '**Activities to Try at Home**' suggestions, as they are so important when supporting young children as they learn. This is such a good opportunity to learn new skills; cooking, sewing, gardening, as well as the vitally important turn taking, sharing and other educational skills to be learned from playing board and card games.

I have included some additional activities which will help your child learn to read and spell words suitable for their stage in development.

A variety of maths activities is enclosed. I am hoping that you can help your child to:-

- measure; length, weight, volume and capacity.
- Name 2D and 3D shapes, and describe their properties – ie a circle has 1 curved edge and 1 flat face, a square has 4 straight sides – all the same length and 4 corners / 4 pointy bits.
- Begin to tell the time – in o'clocks,
- Explore what half of something is.

I really hope you find this useful.

I am sending home a class whiteboard, 2 whiteboard pens with the yellow exercise book. Whiteboards are so useful for the children to be creative - drawing and writing. They are also useful for practicing letter formation, spellings, tricky words etc.

We have all worked together to produce a pack that we hope will be really useful.

We hope you and your loved ones stay healthy and we look forward to seeing you all again in the near future.
