Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing with exciting news about 2 trips we have planned for the summer term!

Firstly, we will be visiting Nyewood Infants School as part of our Bishop Luffa Learning Partnership joint learning experience. We will be working with Nyewood Infants and West Dean Schools to create a joint project which will result in the children creating patchwork squares which will be made into a quilt. The quilt will be made of squares from each of the partnership schools and each class will be given their own quilt. The textile department at Bishop Luffa will be creating the quilts for us. Children will need to wear trousers or leggings, school jumpers and sensible footwear as we will be taking part in a forest school session. The children will also need a waterproof coat if the weather is rainy.

The date for this trip is **Thursday 16th April**. We will leave school at 9:15am and return by 1:15pm.

Furthermore, we will also be visiting the Weald and Downland Museum to enrich our Big Build Learning Journey. The children will be spending the day learning about buildings from the past and how buildings have changed over time. We will be taking part in a workshop and, hopefully, having a wonderful picnic lunch! Again, the children will need to wear trousers or leggings and a school jumper. Comfortable shoes will be essential as we will be doing a considerable amount of walking around the museum. The children will need a waterproof coat if it decides to rain.

The Date for this trip is **Friday 8th May 2026**. We will leave school at 9:30 and return before the end of the day.

For both of these trips your child will need a packed lunch. Please ensure you have cancelled your hot meals for both of these dates. You can select a packed lunch from Chartwells if you would like a lunch provided. Children will need to ensure they have a water bottle and a healthy lunch – No chocolate or sweets or fizzy drinks please. For the Weald and Downland trip, we will be taking fruit for snack and some digestive biscuits in case all the walking makes us super hungry! The children will need a bag which is easy to carry.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £21 for these trips. We also are grateful to the friends for some financial support towards the cost of the coaches. Please log in to Arbor to give consent and pay for both trips.
