This year we are welcoming 2 authors to school! Neal Layton is an award winning author and illustrator. He lives in Portsmouth and has currently published over 80 books! He will be visiting our KS1 children on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> October in the afternoon, and sharing one of his fabulous books with them.



KS2 have the pleasure of the company of Natasha Farrant on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> October. She lives in London and is incredibly passionate about the books she writes. She has also won some awards for her writing. Her books are full of adventure and have strong characters at their heart. While the **BookFest** supply a book for each child, we pay for the author visit which is significantly discounted thanks to the charity.
