Friends of Lavant Christmas Fair - Room allocations

- Year R & 1 WRENS CLASSROOM: Arts and Crafts ~ 4 volunteers
 This room will have a selection of craft activities for the children to make in exchange
 for a small fee. Such as cards making, tree ornaments, small gifts, decorated biscuits
 etc. The tables will need to overseen and a little clear-up will be needed after each
 child has finished their craft.
- Year 2 ROBIN CLASSROOM: Games ~ 4 volunteers We will have a few games such as Nerf Gun Alley, Pin the nose on Rudolf, snowball in a bucket (or snowman with holes) etc.
- Year 3 & 4 WOODPECKER CLASSROOM: The Tombola Room ~ 6 volunteers This is always a VERY popular room. The non-school Uniform Donation days provide lots of the prizes, but the room needs to be set up the evening before the fair. This includes to label all the goodies with raffle tickets, lay out the stalls and arrange for a person to be on each stall throughout the fair. We have traditionally had a toy tombola, bottle tombola, sweets tombola, 'Everyone's a winner' and teddy tombola.'
- Year 5 & 6 PHEASANT CLASSROOM: Mini-disco, painted nails & tattoos ~ 4
 volunteers For this room it would be great if the volunteers could help with the organising Can you borrow a Karaoke machine or speaker? Perhaps you know



someone with a set of disco lights? Can you think of anything new the children might love? The Friends have a stash of tattoos, nail varnish, glitter & face paints for you to use. We can supply tuck if you are able to bag it up and sell it. Perhaps there is something else we haven't thought of? This room will need to be manned for the fair.

The classrooms will be free to be set up from 3.15pm on Friday 29 November.
