Applying for a capital grant from council as it's tied in with wrap around care. May be able to use it for events and sell teas etc from it. The reflective area outside will get a revamp of it and the area around stage with log seating. Adrian is speaking to south downs and we may need to get full planning permission. Should be done for the summer holidays.
