### Tapestry – Setting activities to continue your child’s learning at home

Further to our recent communications regarding access to Tapestry at home. Please be advised that I shall be using Tapestry to communicate with you about activities to continue your child’s learning during the school closure. You will be able to access these activities through ‘Observations’ within Tapestry.

When you log into Tapestry you will be able to access your child’s Observations by clicking on Observations at the top left of the screen. Over the next few weeks, I will add daily tasks for you to complete at home with your child, these will be the first Observations to appear in the list and will have a title and show the date, which I have added them. Please can you help your child to complete these tasks to continue their learning during this time.

To access these activities, click on the title in blue of the Observation. Here you will see details of the task set. Once you have viewed the daily task, exit this by clicking on to Observations at the top left of the screen.

When you have helped your child to complete this activity, please add a new Observation by clicking on +Add observation. Enter a title and any comments (Notes) about your child’s learning with this work. You can also upload photos of the work under Media, within the Observation. Once you save this observation, I will be able to access this within Tapestry.

It is important that your child’s learning continues during this time and with your help, using Tapestry to record their learning, I will be able to continue monitoring their progress.
