



SHOEBOX 2021

We are delighted to confirm that Lavant CE Primary School will once again be participating in the nationwide and well-established SHOEBOX scheme being organised locally by Rotary Chichester Priory. Last year we had a fantastic response from Lavant families and we hope that you will want to take part again this year. SHOEBOX will deliver Christmas presents to underprivileged children in Albania, Montenegro, Moldova, Romania and the Philippines.

The premise of the scheme is very simple. We ask you to fill a box (a shoebox is ideal) with new, or very good second-hand, items for either a boy or girl in the following age-group categories: 1-3 years; 4-7 years; 8-11 years; or 12-15 years of age.



These items could be soft toys and picture books for the youngest children, through to educational books, games, jigsaws, crayons and drawing books for the older children. Experience has shown that other items, such as tooth brushes, tooth paste, hair brushes, flannels, socks, knitted hats and gloves have also been very well received by under-privileged children in the past.

You may also include a Christmas card from your family if you wish.

A full set of instructions for the project is included.

We will be collecting completed boxes at the school from Monday 1 November – immediately after half term.

May we thank you most sincerely in advance for taking part in this year's SHOEBOX scheme, which will ensure that an underprivileged child somewhere in these countries will receive a Christmas present on the day.
