Warm Weather

As we enter the summer months please can you ensure your child is well prepared for the warmer weather. School water bottles must be in school every day to enable children to have access to water throughout the day. (**Please do not substitute the school bottle for a home alternative**). All children are provided with a new water bottle at the start of each academic year; however, if you need to replace your child's bottle they can be purchased from the office for £2. Children may now bring in a cap to wear outside to protect their head. Please also remember to apply sun cream before school every day, even if it is cloudy first thing.

Punctuality

A big thank you to all parents who consistently ensure their children arrive at school on time. There are sadly a few families who are regularly arriving after the school gates are shut. Arriving late does not only reduce learning time for your child but causes disruption in class as staff members have to stop supporting children, to unlock the gates and supervise the late arrival into class. Please can all parents ensure their children are in school by 9am. If arriving after 9am, the adult accompanying the child must report to the school office and sign the late book providing a reason for lateness. Later this term we are hoping to be able to open up our school grounds again to enable children to be dropped off at their classroom doors.

Over the past year we have really missed being able to offer so many of the usual activities that really enrich the learning of our children. We are delighted that, as restrictions are relaxed, we are now able to gradually reintroduce some of our wider curriculum initiatives.
