3. Review of Minutes of last meeting

## 4. Financial Overview

Film Bank Media have requested $£ 149$ for any films that we have shown this year. It was agreed that this would be renewed.
Gift Aid - Everything takes a very long time. On 29.4 Lorraine was told it would be 2 weeks. We can then claim back 4 years. Potential claim values are detailed on the financial overview.

There is still more money to come in for 2 for 2022 and the total has already reached almost $£ 3000!!$ Woodpecker class won by a long way as 20 of the 55 children who joined in were in that class. AK and PP will arrange the date for the non-uniform day. The Friends will let the children and parents know what the money has been used for and the school council will have some input in how the money is spent.

LF is still chasing Sally Till for the two years of accounts that are not available at the moment. ST may need to buy Quick Books again for a month to get it back. LF aims to get the Gift Aid sorted out by the end of June. We need to get as many gift aid forms as possible. It was suggested that for each person who fills in a gift aid form will be in with the chance of winning a prize.

LF asked for someone to take over the Parish Council liason. PP said that LF can give the email address for the Friends email address to Jenny Quest.

Request from Mrs Goman she has asked if the money from her swim can go towards another basketball hoop. This was agreed. They are about $£ 150$. The school will purchase this and invoice the Friends as they get the VAT back.

The Curriculum Kitchen was discussed. It has been redesigned to make it more useable for breakfast club and also use for lessons, this will also include some storage from the Friends. The insurance will cover most of this however there is a shortfall (of approximately $£ 2800$ )
due to the insurance company taking $25 \%$ off for depreciation. It was agreed that the Friends would provide $£ 3000$ to complete the kitchen.

## 6. Update on events for Summer term events

a. Update on bingo night

Bingo night has been postponed as nothing has been done so far. PP will cancel this on facebook. This will now take place in the Autumn Term.
b. Summer disco

AK said that it would be good to have a summer social this year. If the school can find a solution to holding the summer production, then it will be the week of $11^{\text {th }}$ July on the Wednesday (Matinee) and Friday (evening). The social event will be Thursday $14^{\text {th }}$ July.
