Dear Parents,

As you know wherever possible we try to make our learning experiences come to life for the children. To that end we have planned an exciting visit to Butser Ancient Farm on Tuesday 7th November to link with a learning journey based on Boudicca and the Iron Age Celts. The trip provides an excellent opportunity for the children to immerse themselves into Iron Age life and what it would have been like to be a Celt. They will get the opportunity to tour a replica Iron Age settlement and complete 4 different activities including a jewellery making workshop.

On the day of the visit the children will need to wear their school jumper and top with some old comfy, warm trousers as some of our activities will be outside. Depending on the weather, trainers or wellies would also be advisable.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch in a bag or back pack and if your child normally has a Chartwells hot meal, please remember to cancel this for the appropriate day well in advance.

There is a shop at the farm that sells a selection of souvenirs. If your child would like to spend some of their pocket money we would suggest an amount of no more than £3. Please could it be in a named envelope or purse/wallet.

We have tried to keep costs to a minimum but we would appreciate it you could help with a voluntary contribution of £20. This helps to covers the cost of the coach, insurance, entrance fee and 4 practical hands on workshops throughout the day. This may be paid via cash or our school BACS system. As a school we do not have the resources to fund these visits totally ourselves so your contributions are greatly valued. Please do speak to Mr King or one of us in confidence if you are unable to contribute on this occasion.
