
Year 1: Subtract by counting back (not crossing 10) 22/1/21

Tom has been saving for a new book to read. He has saved £16 and his books costs £9. He says he will have £8 left. Do you agree? Can you show what you are thinking on the numberline.





Sarah sometimes finds it tricky to count back so she uses a numberline to help her. These are the questions she has answered in maths today. Can you use your numberline to check her answers and tick if they are right and give her the right answer if they are wrong?

$$15 - 6 = 8$$

$$12 - 7 = 6$$

$$12 - 8 = 4$$

$$18 - 9 = 9$$

$$13 - 4 = 8$$
