Dear Parents,

As part of our next learning journey all about healthy living, we will be taking the children on an educational visit to Tuppenny Barn in Emsworth on Tuesday 26th February. The purpose of the trip is to give children an insight into how healthy fruit and vegetables can be grown locally and how we can produce food in a sustainable way.

We aim to leave school at 9.30am and return after lunch. If your child normally has a hot lunch, a packed lunch (and drink) will be provided for them by Chartwells.
