Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Autumn Term. We have been busy planning some exciting learning opportunities for your children this year.

As you know wherever possible, we try to make our learning experiences come to life for the children. To that end, we have planned an exciting visit to Butser Ancient Farm on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November to link in with a learning journey based on the Celts and Romans. We will also be having a visit on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> November from Paul Ullson, a history expert, to help lead us in a Roman battle.

On the day of the visit the children will need to wear school uniform top and jumper and some old comfy, warm trousers as some of our activities will be outside. Depending on the weather, trainers or wellies would also be advisable.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch in a named bag or back pack and if your child normally has a Chartwells hot meal, please remember to cancel this for the appropriate day well in advance.

There is a shop at the farm that sells a selection of souvenirs. If your child would like to spend some of their pocket money, we would suggest an amount of no more than £3. Please could it be in a named envelope or purse/wallet.

We know that we have just asked for contributions towards swimming lessons and have therefore tried to keep costs to a minimum, but we would appreciate it if you could help with a voluntary contribution of £19.70. This covers the cost of the coach, insurance, entrance fee, 4 practical hands on workshops throughout the day and the visit by Paul Ullson. Although the contribution is voluntary, we do need to point out that it is probable that the visit will not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute. As a school we do not have the resources to fund these visits totally ourselves. Please do speak to Mr King or one of us in confidence if you are unable to contribute on this occasion.
