**Governing Body News -** Our team of governors continue to work together to help steer the school and support staff and the community. At the start of the academic year, Mrs. Yelland and Mrs. Shapiro, who have both been active governors for a number of years, stepped down from their governing roles. We thank them for all they have contributed over the past few years.

As always, I am very grateful to all our governors who effectively offer challenge and support to our school. Their dedication to the children of Lavant and in helping our school grow from strength to strength is hugely important to our development. We currently have two vacancies; a Foundation (Church governor) and Community governor. **School Clubs** – Sadly, due to continued restrictions, we are still not able to offer our usual range of before and after school clubs after half term. This includes Breakfast club as children are still not permitted to mix across bubbles. We are hoping however to be able to offer one SCS lead sports club to once class on a Wednesday after school starting after the half term break. This club is initially being offered to children in Woodpecker class but will be rotated on a half-termly basis if restrictions continue into the spring term. If you have a child in Woodpecker Class, please look out for a letter that will be coming home in the next couple of days if you are interested in your child attending this club.

**Safer routes to school -** You will be aware of the increased congestion along West Stoke road at the start and end of the day. We are increasingly concerned for the safety of our children and families arriving and leaving school and are setting up a working party to explore ways in which we can improve the safety for all concerned. If you would like to be involve in this initiative, please let me know.

**Healthy Packed Lunches -** We have noticed that a number of children have begun to have an increasing number of unhealthy items in their lunch boxes. Please can all parents ensure children's lunches are healthy. Children are not permitted to bring in bars of chocolate or sweets or anything containing nuts. Morning snacks must be either a piece of fruit or vegetable.

**Individual photos** - The photographer will be in school on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> November to take individual photos of all the children. Please ensure your child is in their smartest uniform on that day. It is unlikely that we will be able to offer the chance for pre-school siblings to have their photo taken with their siblings this year, but I will let you know if this situation changes.

**Christmas** – Many thanks to all of you who made such generous donations toward our Christmas hampers last week. As we are sadly unable to hold our biggest fundraiser of the year, our Christmas fair, we are hoping to raise as much money as possible through an amazing Christmas raffle. A second non-uniform day for further donations will be held on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November.

This week you will also receive two additional letters regarding **Christmas half term projects**.

The first is another Friends fundraiser to **design your own Christmas card**. This would be a lovely  $\frac{1}{2}$  term project and would enable you to send your very own bespoke Christmas cards to friends and family.
