Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we get closer to our performances of *Aladdin Jr.*, we wanted to send a few final reminders to help everything run as smoothly as possible.

Timings

*Dress Rehearsal – Tuesday 14th July, **13:30** (pick-up at Lavant Memorial Hall at 15:15)*

*Matinee Performance - Wednesday 15th July, **14:00** (doors open 13:40, pick-up at 15:40)*

*Evening Performance - Thursday 16th July, All children to return to Lavant Memorial Hall at **17:00 for our 17:30 performance** (doors open 17:10)*

Any children attending Activ8 Wraparound care on Tuesday or Wednesday will be transported back to school by members of staff after the show.

Tickets

We hope you have managed to purchase your tickets for our performances. There are tickets remaining for both shows (and a few more left for the matinee) and as such, remaining tickets will be released for general sale on **Saturday at 10:00** through the same link as previously. If you already have two tickets and you would like to buy another, these will be released on a first come, first served basis until the full allocation is met.

Costumes

Thank you to everyone who has already provided costume items – we really appreciate your support. If you have not yet sent in any requested costume items, please ensure they are brought into school as soon as possible, clearly labelled with your child's name.

Footwear

For the performance, children should wear **dark, soft-soled shoes**, such as school shoes or dark plimsolls, unless we have agreed something specific for their costume. Children should not wear trainers.

Keeping Cool

The weather forecast suggests it is likely to be very warm during the performances. We would strongly recommend that audience members consider bringing a **small handheld fan** to help keep comfortable.

For the performers, whilst we would not normally have children keep water bottles on the performance mats where they sing, we feel it will be important for this production due to the expected heat. Please ensure your child brings a **clearly named, sensible water bottle** (one that is unlikely to leak or spill, and **not metal as they can be quite loud on the hall floor**) so they can stay hydrated throughout the performance.

A Long Shot...

Finally, we have one slightly unusual request! If anyone happens to have access to a **larger portable air-conditioning unit** through work or otherwise, and would be willing to lend it to us



for the performances, we would be incredibly grateful. We know it's a long shot, but we thought it was worth asking if it might help us keep the hall a little cooler for both our performers and audience.

After the Performance

At the end of each performance, we will get the children back to you as quickly as possible. They will be dismissed from the **Village Green side of the Memorial Hall onto the field**. We appreciate your patience while we ensure every child is safely reunited with their family.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support. We are so excited to share *Aladdin Jr.* with you and can't wait for you to see all the hard work the children have put into creating a fantastic show.
