## Chartwell hot dinners.

We are aware that many of you have experienced difficulties this week logging on to your new parent pay account, and we apologise for any inconvenience caused. Unfortunately, this new system has been bought in by West Sussex's catering company, and is not under our control. Please can I remind you that **every parent** does need to register with parent pay, particularly if at any time you may require your child to have a hot dinner. All hot dinners for children in key stage one and children in receipt of free school meals will be booked by the school office up until the 23<sup>rd</sup> January, but after this date, meals will only be provided for children who's parents have gone onto parent pay and booked a meal. All children in receipt of free school meals will also need an account set up and food ordered by their parents. Please note, all meals have to be booked at least 10 days in advance and must be booked by the parents. We realise that this is a very big change and may feel quite overwhelming at the moment but hope that we will all get used to this new system very quickly.

**Spring Term Clubs** – I will send out a letter regarding spring term clubs in the very first week of term. Clubs will commence in the week starting 9<sup>th</sup> January.
