Reports can include speeding, dangerous or anti-social driving behaviours. Any parking concerns should be reported to Chichester District Council. We have been informed that all Operation Crackdown reports generate a reference number. If you make a report and receive a reference number, please can you forward it to the school as we can use it as evidence towards the road improvement scheme request.
